ESTIMATION PROCESS

- 1. Set appointment for estimate.
- 2. Estimator visits home and takes off project.
- 3. Estimate is emailed to client within 48 hours of appointment.
- 4. Once quote is accepted, we ask for a 25% deposit and signed proposal.
- 5. Once deposit is received we schedule work.
- 6. Customer receives a call with a week of start date and we schedule a job walk with the customer and foreman.

FULL EXTERIOR PROCESS

Our Exterior Painting Process

- 1. All areas are to be protected with drop cloths.
- 2. All surfaces or to be soaked with mildicide and fully pressure washed to remove all dirt and mildew.
- 3. All peeling paint to be machine sanded to a feathered finish.
- 4. All shingles in detail work to be prepared with hand tools.
- 5. All glossy surfaces will be light sanded to assure proper adhesion.
- 6. Replacement carpentry (if specified) will be performed to replace all rotten or damaged wood and assure proper adhesion of the paint.
- 7. All open seams in siding and trim to be fully caulked to seal out moisture.
- 8. All holes and divots on siding and trim to be filled with two component epoxy.
- 9. All prepared surfaces and bare wood to fully primed.
- 10. Factory finish on all gutters to be cleaned. Previously painted gutters to be repainted.
- 11. Exterior glass to be razored clean at the completion of the work.
- 12. Apply two coats on the highest quality Benjamin Moore or Sherwin Williams paints to surfaces.
- 13. Job site to be left clean.

FULL INTERIOR PROCESS

Our Interior Painting Process

- 1. All furnishings and floors will be covered and protected.
- 2. Walls and ceiling will be scraped, patched, sanded. Prep work to be re-inspected and re-coated with compound as necessary before final coats are applied.
- 3. Cracks in walls and ceilings will be filled with compound, let dry and sanded smooth.
- 4. More advanced cracks or receive an application of fiberglass tape. Apply two coats of plaster and sand smooth.
- 5. Glossy services and trim will be sanded and cleaned it to assure proper adhesion.
- 6. Rough areas due to previous paint failure will be scraped and sanded.
- 7. Cracks in the wood trim and along wall/trim interface will be caulked.
- 8. A stain sealer will be applied to water and tannin wood stains.
- 9. All damaged glazing in window sashes to be removed and re-glazed to properly seal the window muntins.
- 10. Work area will be cleaned up and vacuumed. All debris will be taken away.
- 11. Upon completion, leftover paint will be labeled and left at the job site.
- 12. Hardware will be removed and reinstalled. This includes curtain rods, window latches, switch plates, cover plates. Door knobs, thermostats, alarm systems will not be removed.
- 13. Apply two coats of the highest quality Benjamin Moore or Sherwin-Williams paint to all surfaces.
